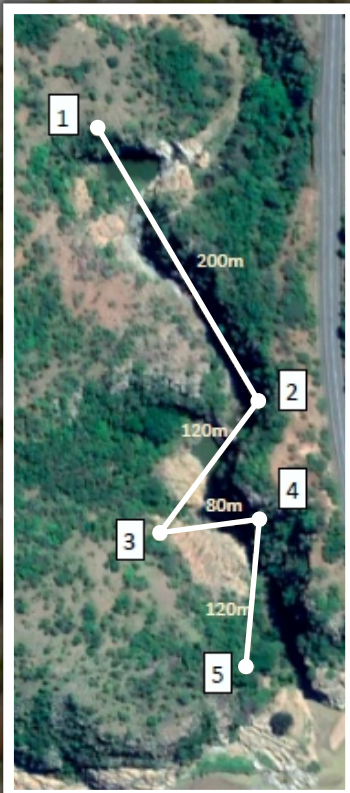
All accommodation is provided in Safari-Style Tents

in a separate location to the camp

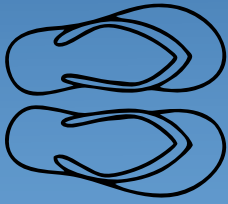
EXTRA FUN FEATURES AT OUR CAMP!

of the Nhlazatshe valley and Umfolozi river

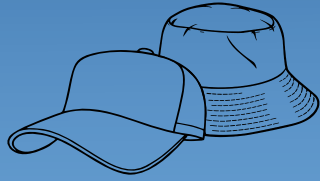
We also have a newly built 520m length Zipline Course running
through Matatane Camp consisting of 5 platforms



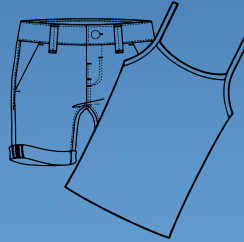
